


Spring 1 - Year 1

Communication, Language & Literacy

Literacy

We will be using 'The Lion Inside' by Rachel Bright & Jim Field. The children will be writing a story based upon a character taking a journey. We will continue to focus upon capital letters, finger spaces and full stops, as well developing our use of adjectives, conjunctions and many different forms of punctuation.



Problem Solving & Reasoning

Maths

The children will continue to look at 2D and 3D shapes. We will then move to composition of numbers from 6-10 and then addition structures.

Creative Development

PE

This half term our PE topics are *Gymnastics* and *Personal Challenges*.

Music

The children will be learning the words, actions and songs for our Christmas performance

Knowledge & Understanding of the World

Science

We will focus on 'Animals including Humans'. The children will learn about the similarities and differences between humans and many different animals. We will also begin to group many different animals based upon their features.

Geography

This term, the children will investigate the weather across the UK. We will look at weather symbols and patterns, and will look at similarities and differences across the 4 countries that make up the UK.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

PSHE

Our PSHE topic is 'Health and Well-being'.

RE

The children will focus on Christianity and will attempt to answer the question 'Why do Christians say that God is a Father?'

Computing

This half term, we will continue to learn about E-Safety and how to communicate sensibly, how to access and navigate the internet and Seesaw, learn how to edit text and images, and also create festive digital art.

Art

This term, the children will complete a sculpting unit inspired by the work of Louise Bourgeois.
