

Summer 2 - Year 1

Communication, Language & Literacy

Literacy

We will be working with the story 'Goldilocks and Just the One Bear'. The children will be writing their own story. We will also continue to focus upon capital letters, finger spaces and full stops, as well developing our use of adjectives, conjunctions and many different forms of punctuation.

Problem Solving & Reasoning

Maths

The children will be solving problems in a range of contexts, looking at position and direction including fractions of turns. We will then look at time sequencing events and telling the time.

Knowledge & Understanding of the World

Science

This term, we will be focusing on Plants. This will include identifying different types of plants and their parts. We will also explore what plants need to grow and observe changes over time.

History

This term, the children are learning about 'Castles.' The children will attempt to answer the question 'Who built castles and why?'

This half term, we will continue to learn about E Safety and how to communicate sensibly. We will also begin to learn how Seesaw works.
