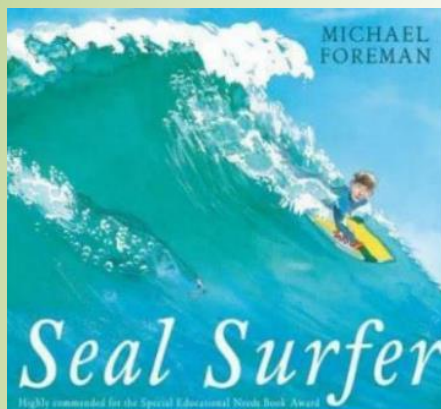


Autumn 1 - Year 3

Communication, Language & Literacy

Literacy

We will be using Michael Foreman's Seal Surfer as a stimulus for writing this half term. We will be writing recounts in letter writing style



French

In French Our very first Language topic is called 'A New Start.' We will be learning to ask and answer our names; ask and answer simple questions about feelings; count from 0-11 and name six colours.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

PSHE

We will be starting PSHE this year by looking at My healthy self: How can I take care of my mind and body? We will be examining the connection between our minds and bodies and learning how to recognise and describe our

Creative Development

PE

Our indoor topic is Health and wellbeing: mindfulness and meditative balances. Within this we will consider how we feel in our mind and our body as well and using meditative balances to help combat some feelings.

Our outdoor PE topic is Invasion games: principles of attack and defence in netball. We will focus on attacking and defending, with focus on passing, moving and scoring.

Computing

This half term we will be learning how to create documents using different apps such as Key note, Pages, Pic collage and Comic Life 3.

Art

We will be completing a unit called Growing Artists, with a botanical theme. We will learn the use of shapes, shading, and texture in art to enhance our drawing skills in order to give a sense of light and dark in our work. We will be experimenting with different tools to create expressive and abstract art. Artist focus: Georgia O'Keeffe.

Music

Our topic to begin with is called Hear it, play it! Exploring rhythmic patterns. We will be feeling and coping pulses and patterns, responding to them, performing some before creating out own rhythmic patterns.

Problem Solving & Reasoning

Maths

Our maths topics this half term will be:

- Review strategies for adding and subtracting across 10.
- Securing place value to 100 and applying to addition and subtraction.
- Bridging 100: counting on and back in 10s, adding/subtracting multiples of 10.
- Measuring length and recording in tables.

Knowledge & Understanding of the World

Science

Our new science topic is Light and Dark - we will be learning about the behavior of light and the formation of shadows.

History

This term, we will be studying the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will learn how early man began as hunter gatherers and then developed to form settlements.

RE

This half term, we will be learning about Christianity. We will be focusing on the question, 'What does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus?'
