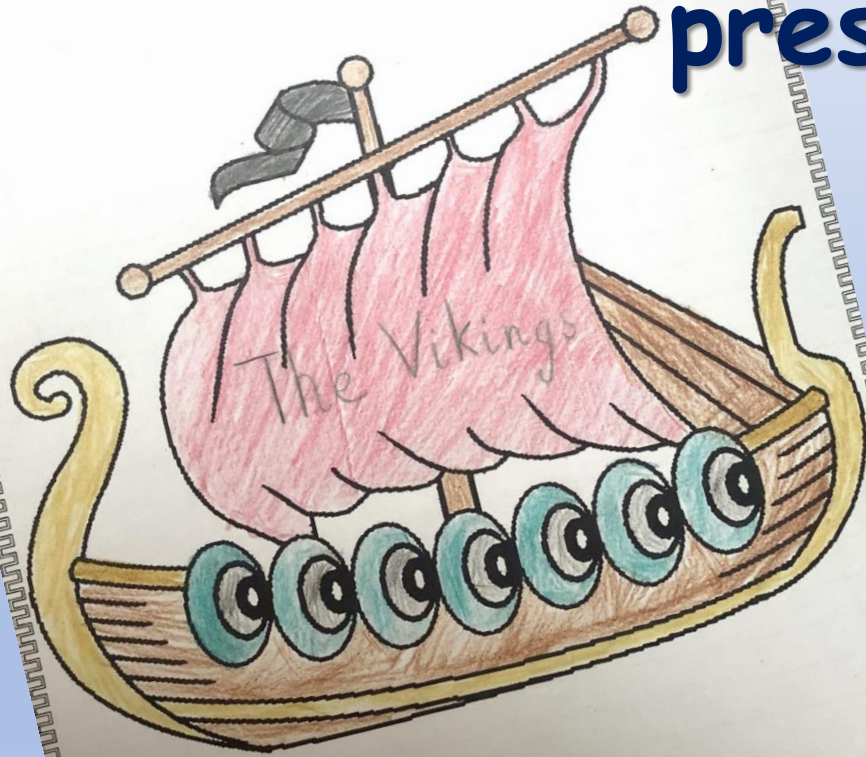
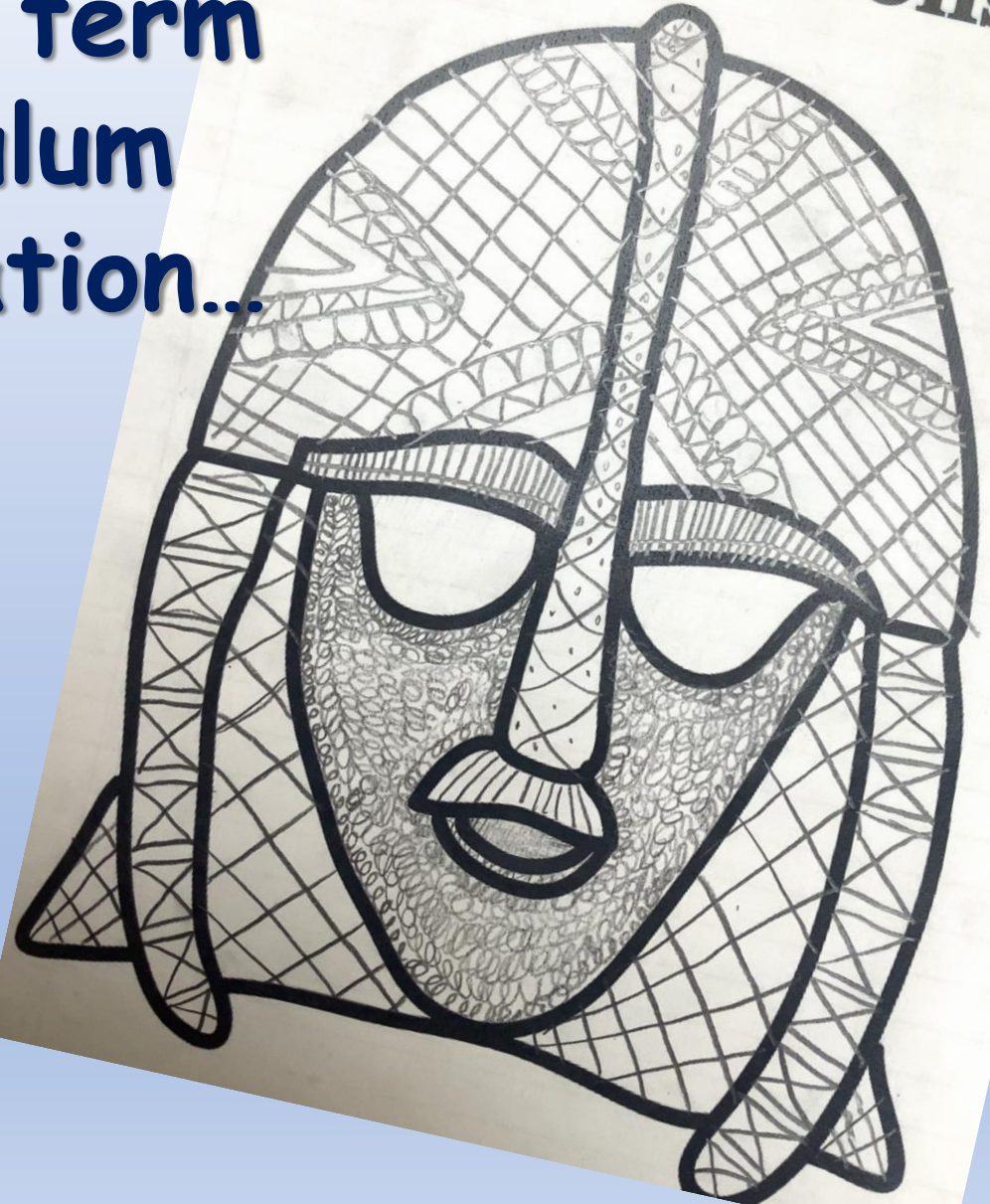


Pirates of the Sea

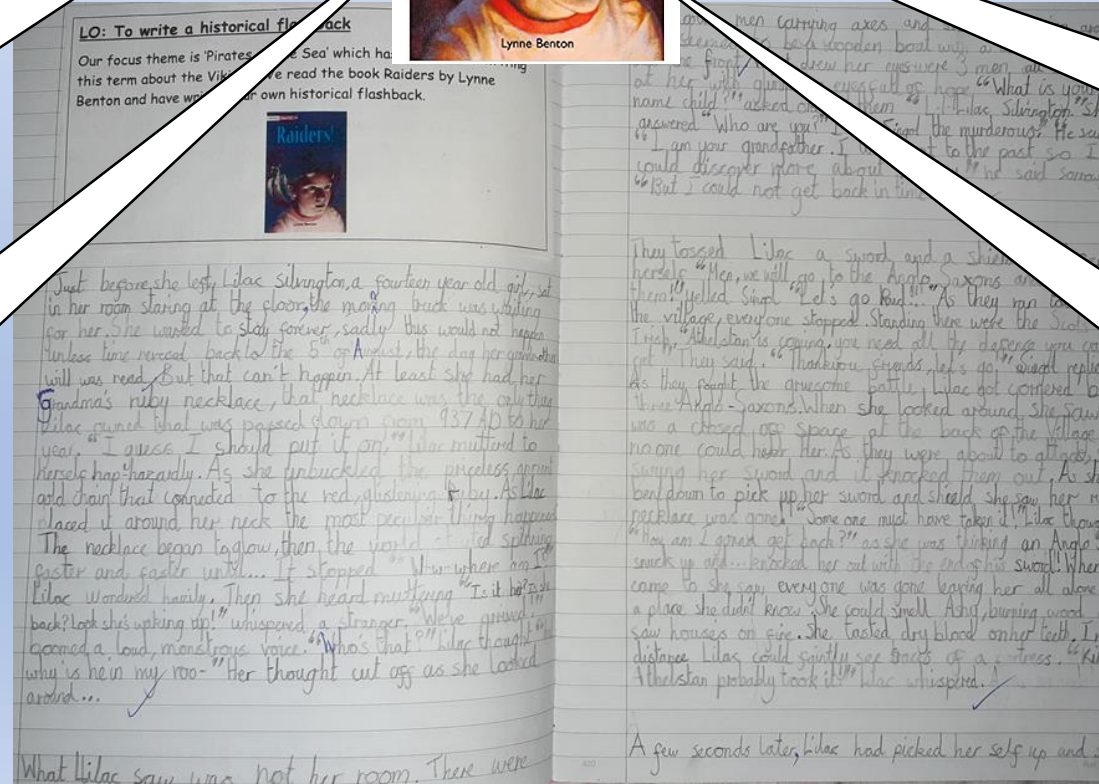
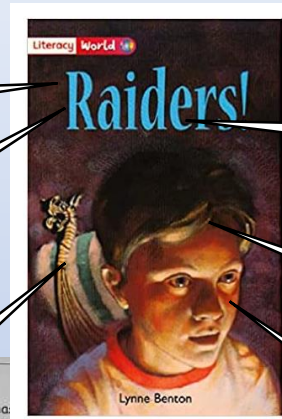
I was captivated with the time travelling.

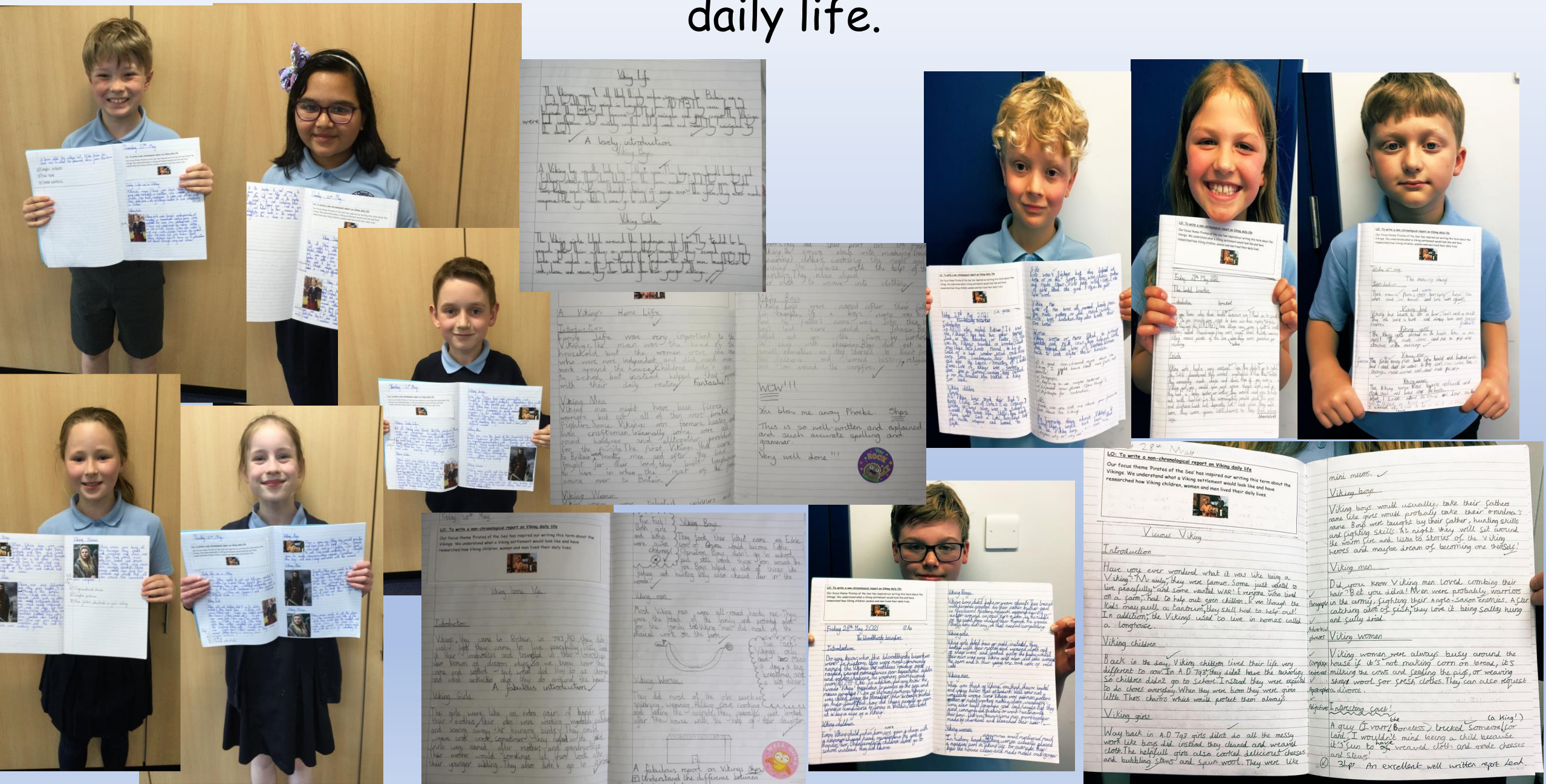
I was very proud of my own flashback story inspired by our focus text.

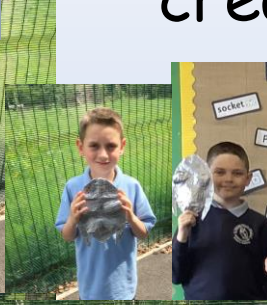
I enjoyed predicting what the story would be about.

In Art, we have researched the Sutton-Hoo burial site. This inspired us to create our own Anglo-Saxon mask.



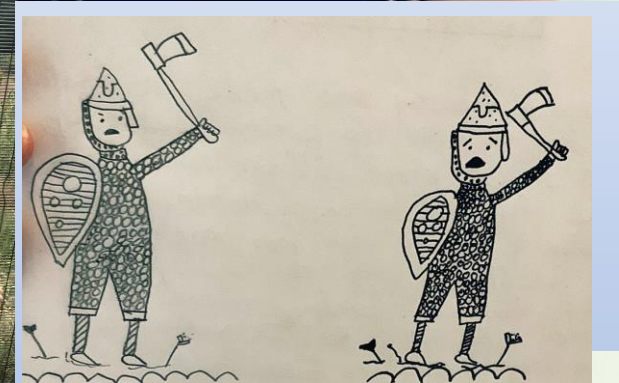
We have been inspired by Pablo Picasso.

Can you see the musical instruments?



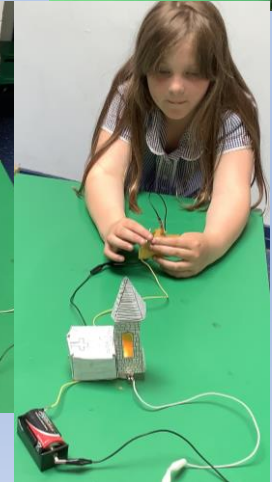
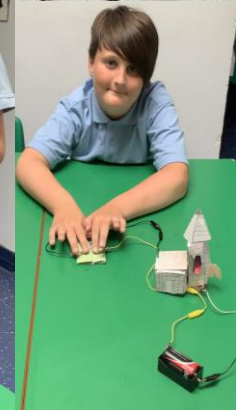
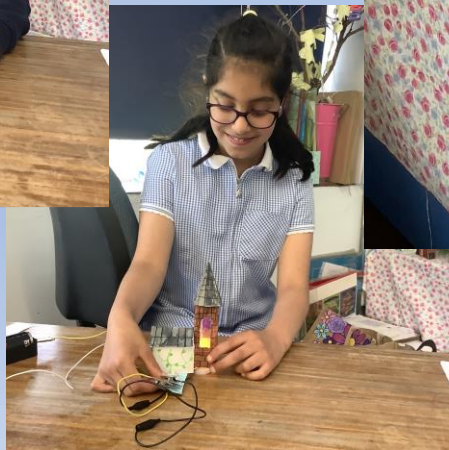
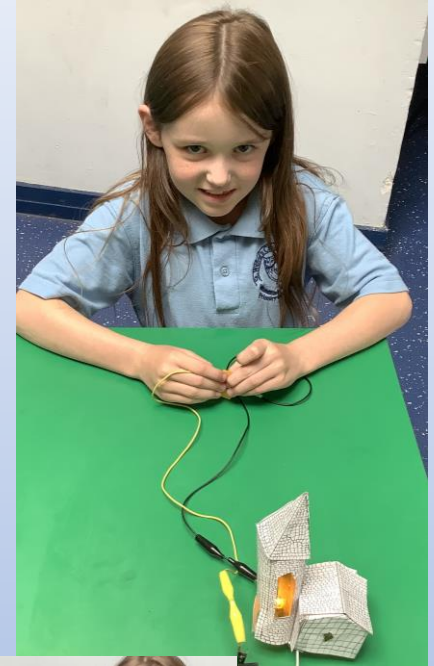
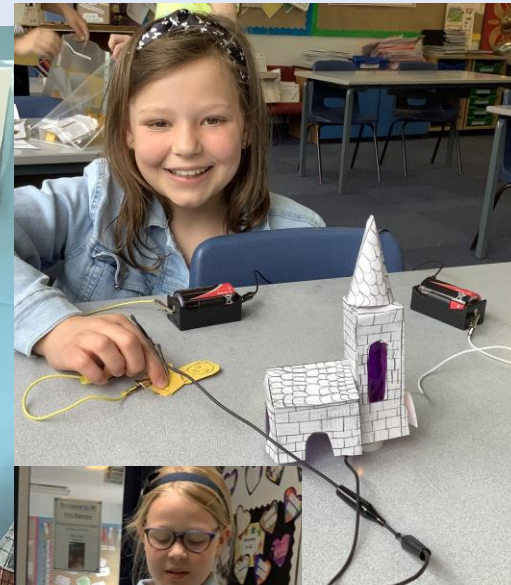
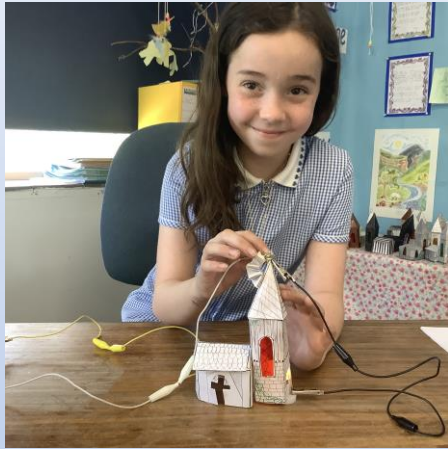
Music and Wider Opportunities has been exciting this year.

the Bayeux Tapestry.



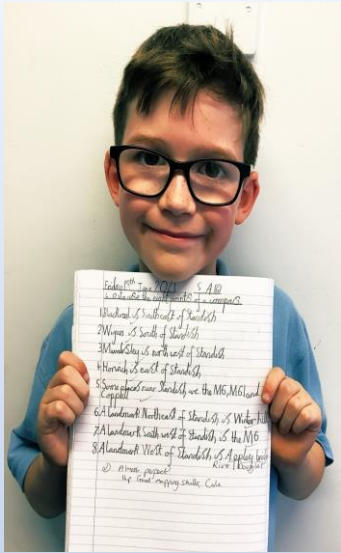
We have also made a 3D church light up using an electrical circuit and a switch, linking to our Science and RE topics.



In this term's RE the children have looked at the qualities of inspirational people before thinking about the Christian values that are important in our lives.

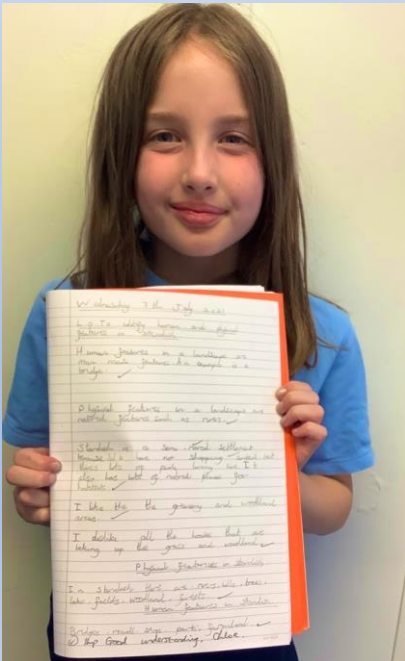


Our focus in Geography has been Standish.

 - 4) Horwich is East of Standish.
 - 5) Blackrod, Haigh and Coppull are all places close to Standish.
 - 6) Winter Hill is a landmark North East of Standish.
 - 7) The canal is a landmark South West of Standish.
 - 8) Wroughton bar is a landmark West of Standish.

We used a map of the North West, together with the eight points of the compass, to locate places close to Standish.

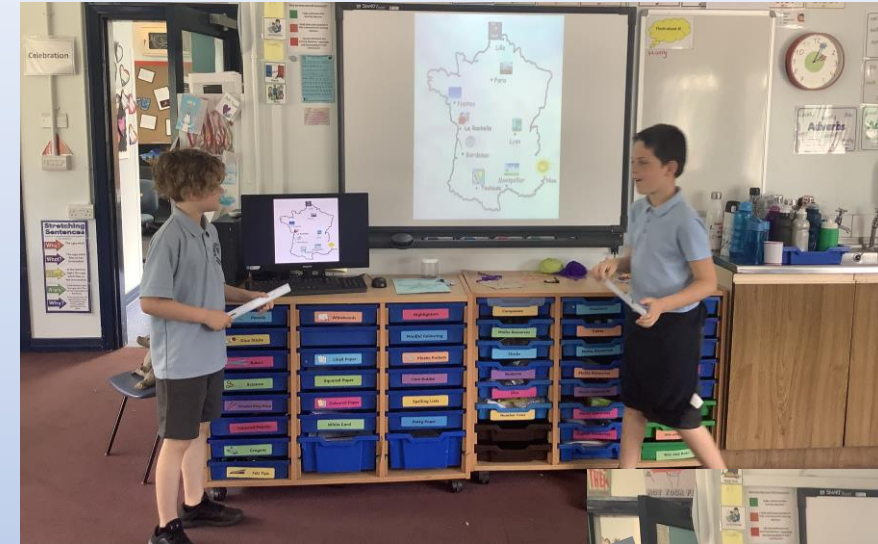


In Science, we have looked at living things and their habitats.
