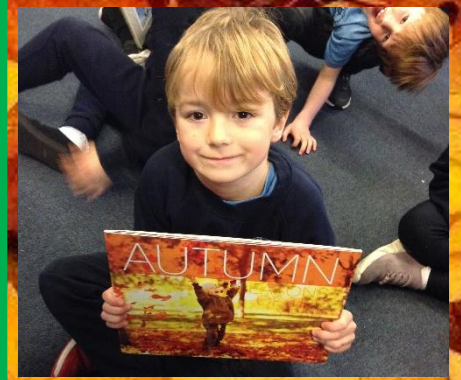

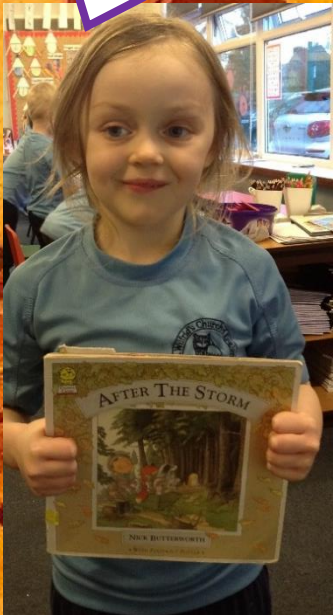
Our focus theme for the Autumn Term was

by Nick Butterworth.



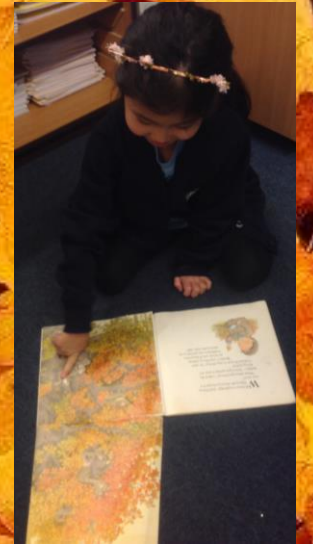
I liked the part

of Autumn.

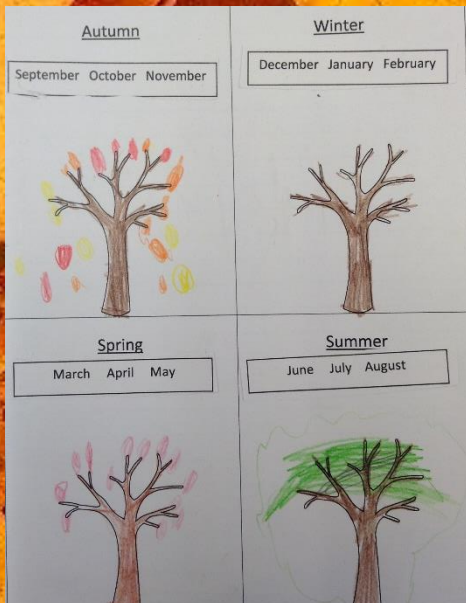
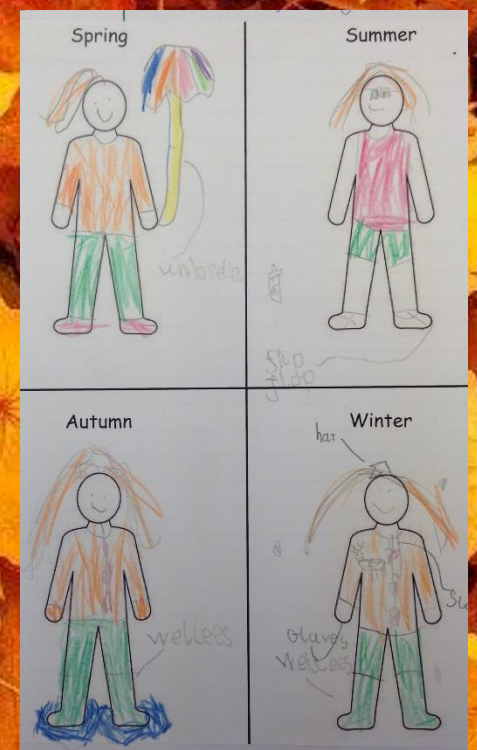


I liked Percy

as a team.



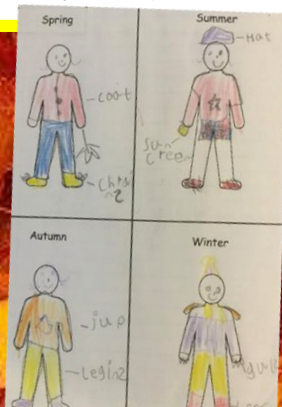
I liked it when the

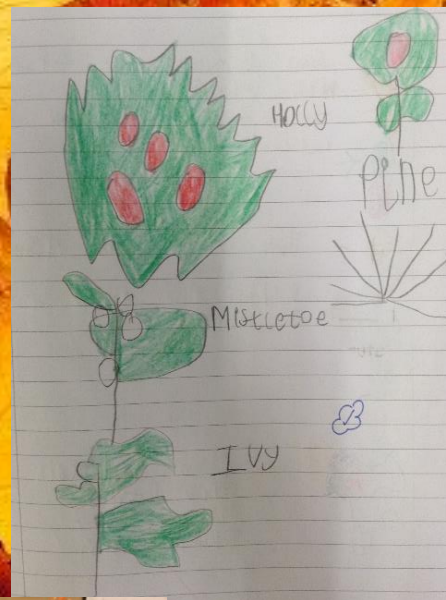




Deciduous trees

trees are there? ✓

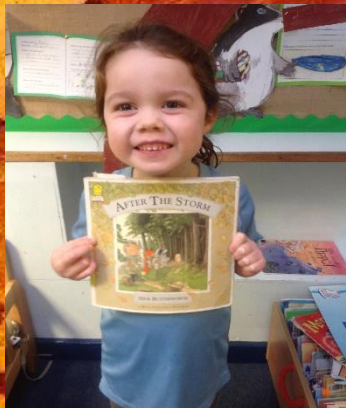
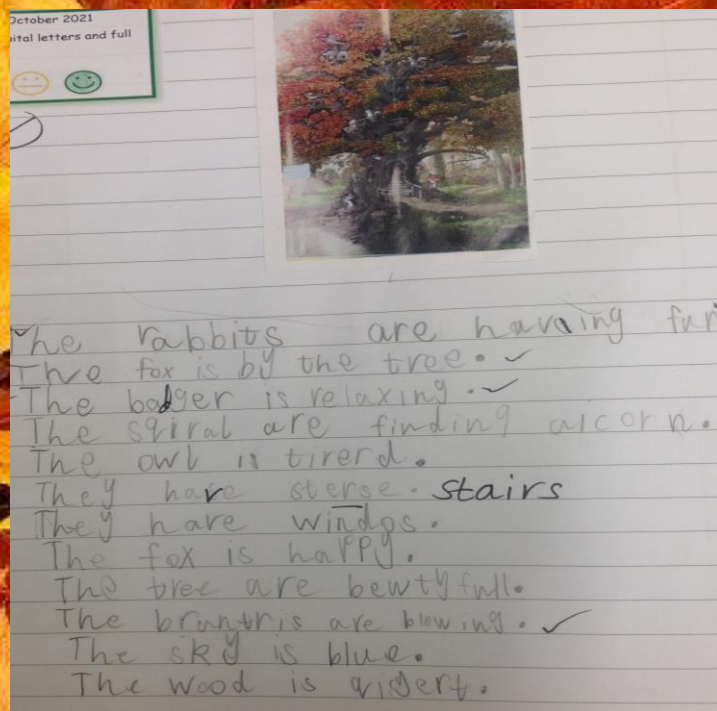
Holly leaves are

brown pine cones. ✓

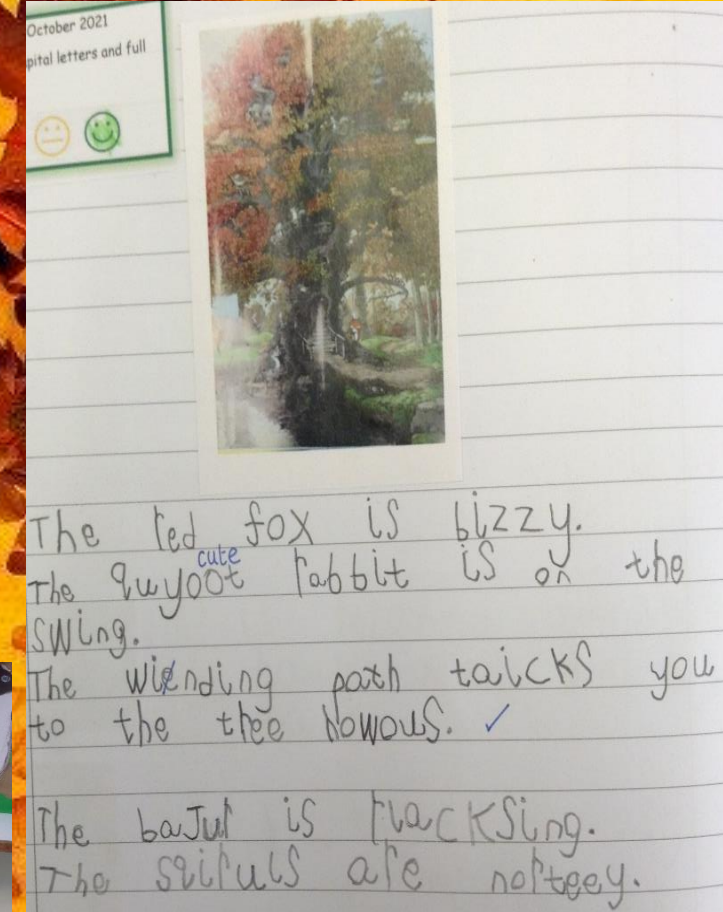
Ivy leaves have
