I like the deer that looks like it's jumping across the land. I don't like the blue and green grass on the picture.

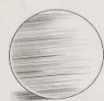

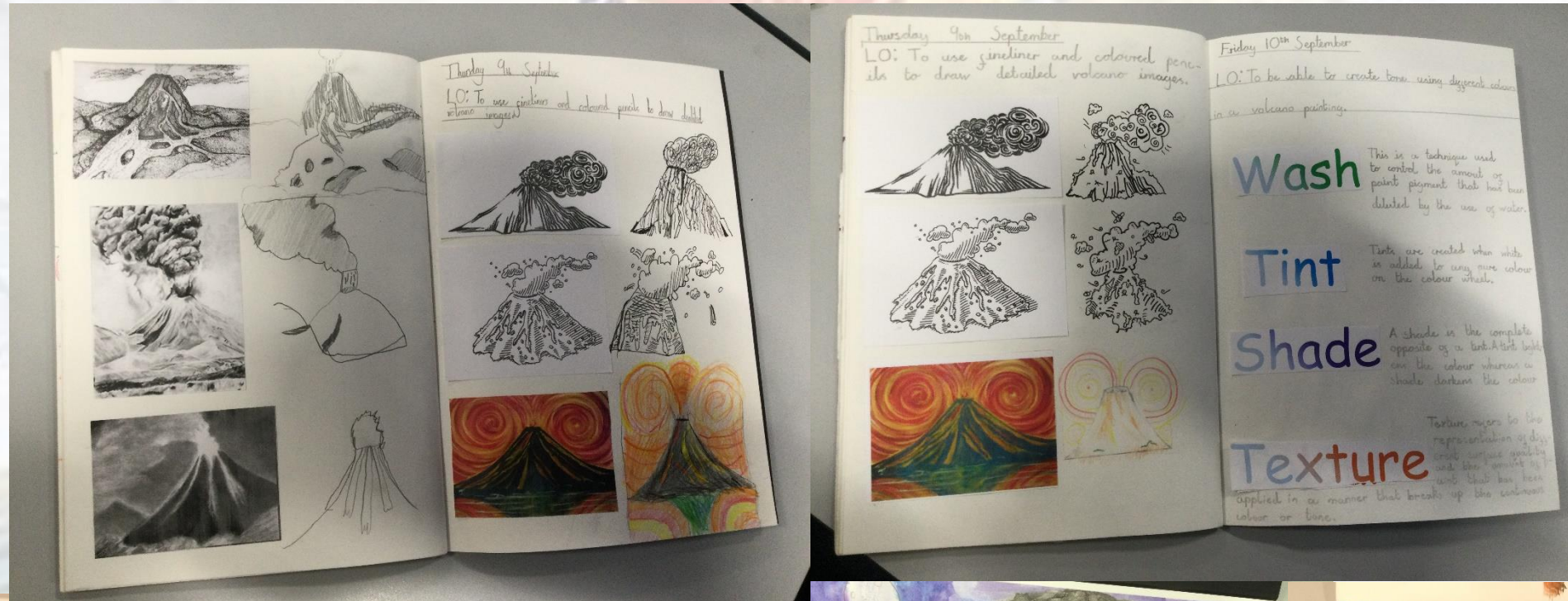
