


# Our focus theme this term has been 'Exhilarating Expeditions'.




We have been learning all about rivers in Geography, reading journey texts in English and Claude Monet in Art.

# Our focus text this term has been...






In English, we have been writing diary entries, from the perspective of Maia, describing our journey through the Amazon rainforest and meeting our distant relatives.

# Art - Claude Monet




In Art, we have been studying the work of Monet. We studied his series of Water Lilly paintings and used them as inspiration for our own collages.







# In DT, we studied CAM mechanisms and produced a working toy based on our river theme.




