Year 1 Our focus theme for the Autumn Term was Seasons come, Seasons Go.


Our focus text was Percy the Park Keeper, After the Storm, by Nick Butterworth.


I liked the way Percy the Park Keeper story teaches us about nature and the season of Autumn.




