by Nick Butterworth.

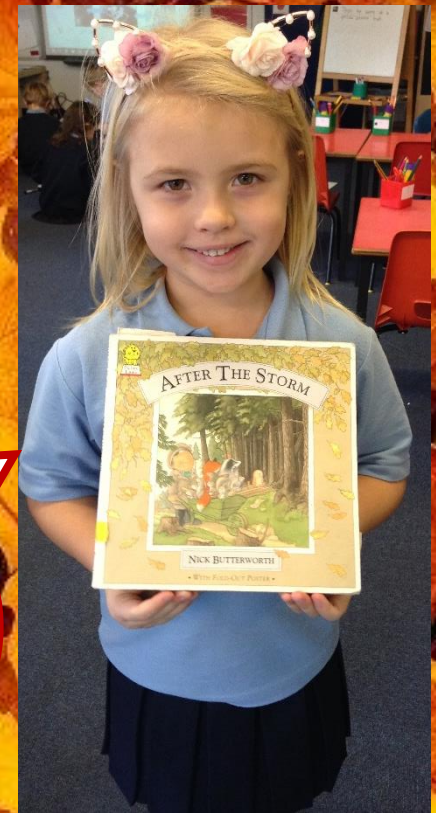
I liked the part

of Autumn.

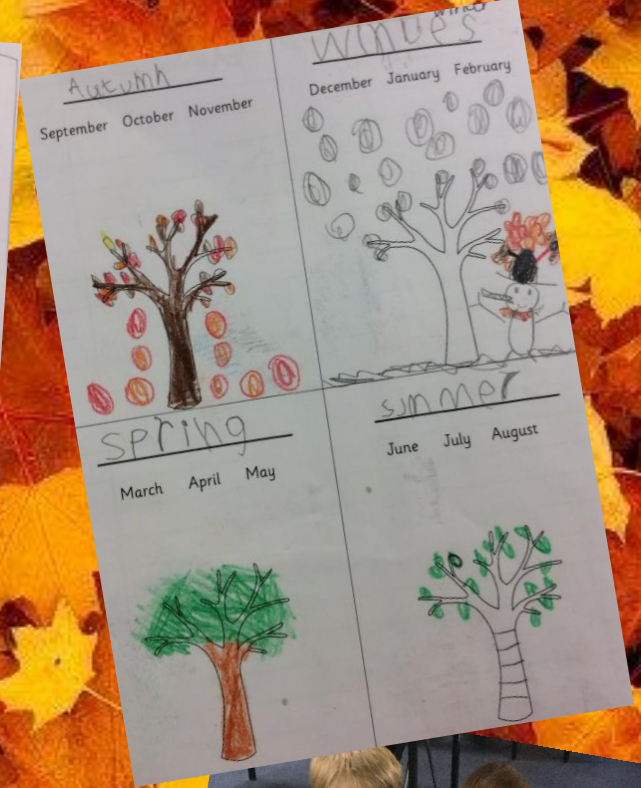

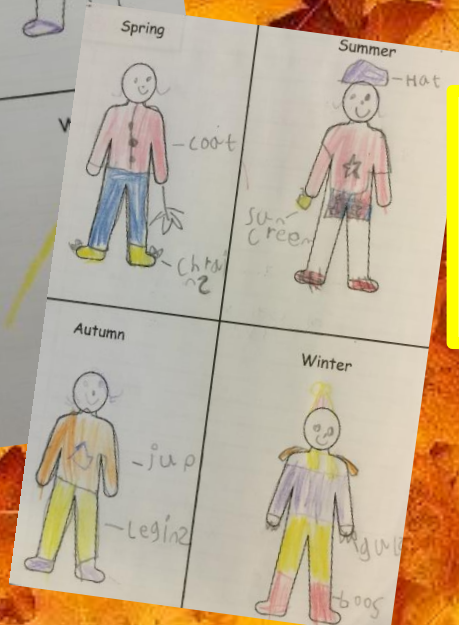
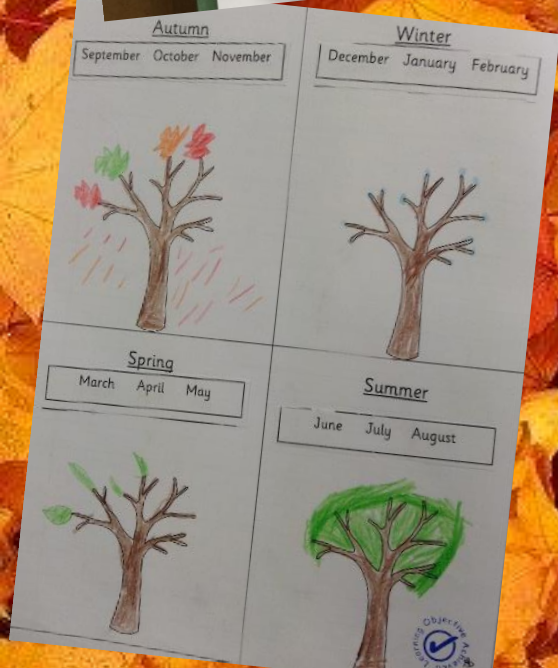


We've learnt about the 4 seasons.

We learnt lots of facts about Autumn by reading our Related Reads.




Then we made non-fiction books all about trees. Look at our amazing facts!

every Autumn.




