All Year Groups:	<i>Geography develops children's curiosity and fascination about the world and its people, building knowledge of the UK, their locality and the wider world. Children develop locational and place knowledge, exploring the human and physical features and processes that shape different environments and how these change over time. Through the curriculum, children develop geographical vocabulary and skills, learning to use maps, atlases, globes and digital mapping, interpret geographical information and communicate their findings. Fieldwork and first-hand experiences enable children to observe, measure, record and investigate the human and physical geography of their local area and beyond.</i>
