



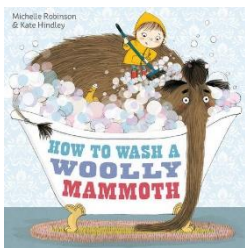
Year 3 Homework: Autumn 2 2025

English

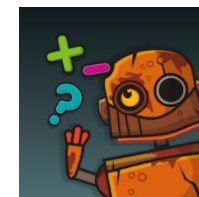
English/Reading

In Shared Reading, we are reading the Illustrated Atlas of Britain and Ireland. We have looked at the different maps and read the information. Choose one of the capital cities to research information. Write 5 facts about your chosen capital city.



Maths

We are continuing to work on our addition and subtraction skills this half term. We have been learning how to add and subtract 3-digit numbers with and without renaming like: $263+415$, $358+426$ and $759-236$, $874-329$. Ask an adult to write some 3-digit questions for you. Use Numbots to continue to practise your addition and subtraction skills.



Science

Later this half term, we are learning about different types of rocks and soils. Go on a 'Rock Scavenger Hunt' in your garden or local park. Can you find: a smooth rock, a bumpy rock, a shiny rock, a beautiful rock, a rock with 2 or more colours. Photograph or draw your rocks and label them.



Science / History (Adult Assistance Required)

Our school logo is a picture of a dripping salt basket, we will be learning about how and where salt is formed. Watch this video to find out how to grow salt crystals and have a try at growing your own at home.
