


Year 3 Homework: Spring 1 2026

<p>English</p>  <p>We will be reading a book called 'Escape from Pompeii'. It is a historical story set in Roman times and is based on a real event from history.</p> <p>Can you find out: Where was Pompeii? What happened in Pompeii? Why would you need to 'escape' from Pompeii? This is our second historical story. If you were writing a story from the past, when would it be set?</p>	<p>English/Reading</p> <p>In Shared Reading, we will be reading a book called 'Volcanoes'. Learn about volcanoes, you could go to the library and get a book or do your own research online (there is a good page on BBC Bitesize: What are Volcanoes?)</p> <p>Make a poster to show what you have learnt about volcanoes.</p> <p>Draw a diagram and write facts.</p> <p>If you're feeling crafty, make a model volcano!</p>	<p>Maths</p>  <p>In maths, we are continuing to look at multiplication and division. With this, we need to be able to recall our 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.</p> <p>Can you use objects at home to make groups of 3, 4 or 8, and then count the groups to help you learn your times tables? Play Times Table Rock Stars to improve your score and your speed.</p>
<p>Science</p>  <p>We are continuing our rocks topic by learning about fossils. Use the BBC Bitesize page: 'What is a fossil?' (www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zt3ntrd#zs6jjsg)</p> <p>Read the information to help you create a timeline of how a fossil is formed. Extra task: Use the website to read about Mary Anning. Who was she and why is she famous?</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Later this half term we will finish our rocks topic by learning about soil. Use the BBC Bitesize page: What is Soil? (www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z9bbkqf/articles/zgqkcmn#zmnaqlr)</p> <p>Read the information and complete an activity. If you have a garden, explore your soil, remember to wash your hands afterwards!</p>	<p>History</p> <p>This half term we are learning about the Romans and why they invaded Britain. Find out 'five fascinating facts' about the Romans.</p> <p>Where did the Romans come from?</p> <p>What did they do in Britain?</p> <p>You might even want to visit Chester to look at the Roman gardens, walls and amphitheatre.</p>
<p>Computing</p>  <p>This half term we are learning about stop-frame animation. We are starting by using some post-it notes to make a flipbook of a stick man waving his arm.</p> <p>Make your own stop-frame flipbook, or use an animation program like Stop Motion Studio (free app) to make your own stop-frame animation.</p>	<p>French</p>  <p>This half term, we are learning how to say family member names in French. Draw a picture of your family and label it with their names in French, or draw your family tree.</p> <p>Key words: mum - mere, dad - pere, brother - frere, sister - soeur, grandad - grand-pere, nan - grand-mere</p>	<p>Art & History</p>  <p>To link with our history topic work, we will be looking at some Roman mosaics. We will learn that they were made out of little pieces of square stones called tesserae.</p> <p>Design and make your own mosaic. You could colour the squares or cut up little pieces of coloured paper.</p>
