

English


We are reading a wordless adventure story called Journey by Aaron Becker. In the book the girl goes on an adventure by using a magic crayon to draw a door that leads to an enchanted forest.

If you had a magic crayon, what would you draw? If you drew a door, where would you go to?



English/Reading

In Shared Reading, we are reading a book called 'The Hodgeheg'. It is about a hedgehog that wants to learn how to cross a busy road, to get to the park on the other side. Write a set of instructions for how to cross a road safely. Practise crossing a road with your adult.



Maths (Adult supervision required)

We are looking at different types of measurement for length, mass and volume in our maths lessons. We have also been looking at, and using, scales to record measurements.

Science
