Key questions:

How do text and images help us communicate a message?

Text and images work together to share information clearly. Text gives details using words, and images help show ideas or make the message easier to understand and more interesting.

What is desktop publishing and what can we make with it?

Desktop publishing is using a computer program to design documents like posters, leaflets or magazines by adding and arranging text and images on a page.

Why is choosing the right font, size and layout important?

Choosing the right font, size and layout helps make information easy to read and helps the reader notice the most important parts of the document.

Image	A picture or photo that is used on a computer to help show information or make work more interesting.
Desktop Publishing	Using a computer program to design and create things like posters, cards, leaflets or magazines using text and images
