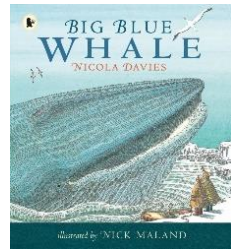

English

Our text for this half term, is a non-fiction book called 'Big Blue Whale' with lots of interesting facts about blue whales.

Make a poster about blue whales using some of the amazing facts that we learn.

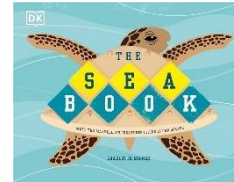
You can do your own research to add more interesting blue whale facts to your poster.



English/Reading

In Shared Reading, we have started reading 'The Sea Book'. It is a non-fiction book that tells us about the different parts of our seas and oceans. Use the website:

Maths/PE



We are continuing to learn about time by looking at how to measure time in minutes and seconds, and by comparing different lengths of time.

Can you record how long it takes you to do:

- 15 star jumps
- 30 hops (15 on each foot)
- throw and catch a ball 20 times
- run around your garden 5 times.

Science

This half term we are learning about plants. Draw and label the main parts of a flowering plant.

How does each part help the plant to grow?

If you have some seeds, plant them and watch them grow over the next few weeks. Take photos of your plant.

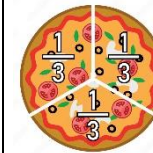


Geography

We have a new topic this term about a small group of volcanic islands near Italy, called the Aeolian Islands. Can you find out the names of the 7 main islands? 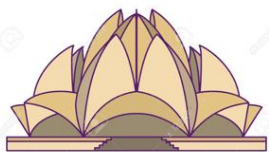
Maths



We will also be learning about fractions. Practise finding and making fractions using things at home, for example cutting a pizza or cake into slices. You could sort a packet of Smarties into their different colours and then write the fractions. RE

This half term, we will be learning about the Baha'i faith and the Lotus Temple. Can you create your own beautiful Lotus Temple. You can draw one or create one using arts and crafts. You may want to use flowers to create your Lotus Temple as it was designed in the shape of a lotus flower.



French

We are learning all about food and drinks. Can you design a menu for a restaurant in French? You can include all of your favourite food and what you would like to serve in your restaurant for breakfast, lunch or dinner (or all three!) Remember to write your prices in Euros. You could also include drawings of the food and drink available.

Later this term, we are looking at painting. We are using colour mixing, to mix primary colours and make secondary colours. Make your own colour wheel using crayons, felts or paints.
