



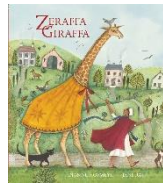
Year 3 Homework: Summer 2 2026

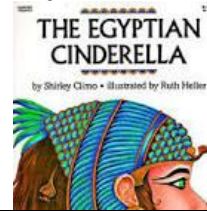
English

In English, we are reading *Zeraffa Giraffa*, the astonishing true story of a giraffe who was sent as a gift from Egypt to France in 1827. It was a long and difficult journey along the River Nile, over the Mediterranean Sea and across France to Paris. How would you get a giraffe from Egypt to France? What transport would you use and how long would it take?



English/Reading

Our Shared Reading book is 'The Egyptian Cinderella', it is the fairy-tale story of Cinderella but set in Ancient Egypt. Can you create your own version of Cinderella set in a different country or different time in history? Or, can you take a different fairy-tale story and put it into an Ancient Egyptian setting?



Maths



We'll be learning about what right angles are and how we can find them in shapes. Can you create a right-angle hunter (like a Pac-Man character) and see what right angles you can find in your house or your garden? We will also be finding the perimeter of different shapes by measuring around them. Measure around 5 objects at home in cms.

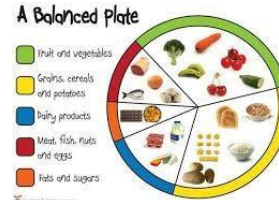
Science

Our topic for this half term is called 'Animals including Humans'. We will be learning about our bodies, our muscles and the different bones that make up our skeleton. Find out how many bones are in a human skeleton. Can you name and label some of the main bones in your body? What are the shortest and longest bones in the human body?



Science

We will be learning about the different food groups that make up a balanced and healthy diet. Keep a food diary of the different things that you eat over one weekend. Look at a picture of a 'Balanced Plate' and find out which food groups your food is from. You could also make a food groups information poster.



History

During this half term we will be learning about Ancient Egypt. Create something to represent Ancient Egypt. For example: design a poster, build a pyramid (this could be out of Lego), make a mummy (wrap up a teddy bear), write your name in hieroglyphics, or create your own cartouche.



RE

This half term we are looking at different religions and how they celebrate their faith. We will learn about Rangoli patterns, how they are made and what they represent. Create your own Rangoli pattern. You could draw and colour your pattern or use something different like coloured tissue paper or flower petals.



French

For our final topic in French, we will be looking at different French landmarks. Can you research some famous places in France and find out interesting facts about them! You could 'visit' the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral, the Louvre Museum or the Arc de Triomphe. Create a visitor leaflet.



History & DT- Egyptian Day Costume

Towards the end of the half term, we will be taking part in our Egyptian Day. For this, you will need an Egyptian style costume. Find out about the Egyptian dresses and tunics, the collars, headdresses, bracelets and amulets that they wore. Can you make something to wear as part of your costume?
