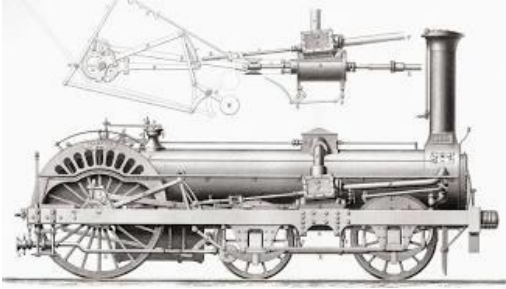


## Year 5 - Holiday Homework
