We are reading a book called Seal Surfer about a boy who meets a seal at the beach. Can you research facts about seals for a seal fact file?

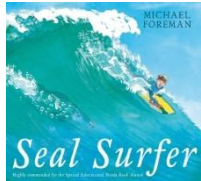
Appearance – What do they look like?

Habitat – Where do they live?

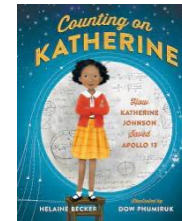

English/Reading

In Shared Reading, we are learning about Katherine Johnson. She helped to plot the flight path for Neil Armstrong's mission Apollo 11, to win the Space Race to the moon. Can you write a diary entry from Katherine's point of view, about the day that Neil Armstrong landed on the moon? Remember to use 'I'.



Maths

This half term we are learning about place value in 3-digit numbers, and number patterns. Practise counting forwards and backwards in 1s, 10s and 100s from any 2 or 3-digit number. We will then be looking at addition and subtraction. Use Numbots to practise your addition and subtraction skills.



Geography

We will be going on our residential to Anglesey soon, before we go, can you find out 'five fascinating facts' about Wales and Anglesey? Can you find out how to say 'hello' in Welsh? Why is there a dragon on the flag? We will be meeting lots of people who live in Anglesey, can you think of three questions to ask them?



Geography

We have been learning about the difference between human and physical features in Wales. Can you find 5 human and 5 physical features in your local area?

Human features have been made by humans for humans. Physical features are naturally grown or created by nature.



Science

We are learning all about light. Can you make your own shadow puppet? You can take a photo or video and upload it to Class Dojo. You can create stick puppets using lolly sticks and paper. You will need a lamp or torch for this activity. You could create a short story too using your stick shadow puppets.



PSHE

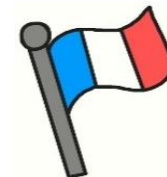
We are looking at feelings and their importance in how they impact our everyday decisions and choices. Can you think of a time that your positive or negative feelings have influenced a choice you have made? For example, you may have had a lovely day at school and then been kind to everyone at home.



French

This half term we are learning about France and French greetings. Can you record yourself having a conversation with a friend or family member, include the French phrases 'bonjour', 'ca va?' and 'au revoir'.

We have also been looking at pictures of France, can you create a tourist information poster with facts about France?



Design Technology

We are looking at levers and linkages, and how to make moving picture books. Can you make your own moving picture? This could be a slider, a pop-up, a wheel or a lever. Can you use two different mechanisms in your moving picture?
