

Homework Projects - Autumn Term (1)

This term our focus in Geography will be looking at significant places in Winsford and Hartington and how the two places are similar and different.

<u>Geography 1</u> What do you like about living in our community? What places do you like to visit in Winsford and why? Write a sentence to explain. Challenge: Can you create a poster advertising Winsford to someone who might want to visit?	<u>Geography 2</u> Go on a walk around Winsford. Can you write a list of all the physical and human features you can find? Challenge: Create an information leaflet or poster explaining what you have found.	<u>Art – Drawing</u> Go on an autumn walk with your family or look for signs of autumn in your garden. Sketch some of the things you find. Challenge: Can you use your pencil to create light and dark tones in different areas?
<u>English – Autumn Senses Writing</u> Go on a walk and use your senses to help you describe what you can see, touch, hear and smell. Challenge: Can you use some adjectives to describe what you saw/touched/heard/smelt?	<u>Science- Everyday Materials</u> Can you find some objects around your home that are made from more than one material? Draw a picture and label what they are made from e.g. glass, plastic, metal, wood. Challenge: Can you describe and record some of the object's properties e.g. hard/soft, smooth/rough, bendy/stiff?	<u>PSHE – Belonging</u> Draw a picture of yourself and write some sentences about you. What are your favourite things and why do you like them? What are your favourite things about you as a person?
<u>DT – Structures</u> This term, our English texts feature trolls! Can you make a home for a troll using junk modelling? It could be a bridge (we know they traditionally like to reside under bridges!) or even a forest cave, like the troll who made a mess in our classrooms! Challenge: Can you create a little troll or find a toy that could be a troll to test your structure. Does your troll/toy fit well in the cave/home? If you've made a bridge, does it hold your troll/toy well? Try to complete one of these tasks each week and record in your homework book. Photos can be sent via dojo. All homework tasks to be completed and handed in before we break up for half term, by Friday 16th October. We look forward to seeing and celebrating your completed homework. Dojos will be given!		<u>English – Reading</u> Visit your local library and pick some books that look fantastic. Read them on your own or with somebody else.
