

Great Moor Junior School Year 6 Autumn Term 2025

English

In Autumn 1 we will be exploring twenty of the most heroic and impressive explorers who ever lived in the Great Adventurers by Alastair Humphreys. Our writing will focus on diary entries and fiction story creations based around the text and our responses to the different explorers and themes. We will analyse the use of technical vocabulary to enhance a text. Reading, comprehension and spelling activities will take place weekly.

During Autumn 2 we will be delving into The Night Bus Hero by Onjali Q. Rauf and analysing homelessness, making connections to our local area and making a change. Lots of learning will be based on writing narratives and letters alongside exploring a range of poems to support our comprehension skills.

Maths

Aut 1: number and place value; mental calculation strategies using all 4 operations; ; factors, multiples, square numbers, cube numbers and prime numbers; and converting measures using powers of 10.

Aut 2: fractions including comparing and using the four operations; long

division and long multiplication.

Computing

1st half term - Website analysis and creation

2nd half term - Creating and formatting spreadsheets

<u>Module</u>

Our first half-term's geography work will focus on sustainability in South America. We will be exploring what life is really like working on plantations in the Amazon and how it affects our climate. We will be deepening our understanding of climate change and looking at ways that we can change the world for the better.

Autumn 2's focus will be on our science topics of Science of Classification—Living things and their habitat, which includes looking at Micro-organisms. In addition, we will be learning about Animals including humans.
