

Great Moor Junior School Year 6 Spring Term 2026



English

Spring 1— Our class book will be 'The Arrival'. Children will be using the book as stimuli to write holiday brochures, as well as writing a fictional text incorporating dialogue. We will also be studying, 'What You Need to be Warm' by Neil Gaiman.

Spring 2- We will be focusing on a range of texts which create a tense atmosphere in the style of 'The Haunting of Aveline Jones' by Phil Hickes. We will also be creating our own inventions. Throughout this half-term, we will study poetry with a focus on 'Meeting Midnight' written by Carol Ann Duffy.

Maths

We will be learning a range of mathematical concepts over the term. These are the main topics:

Spring 1

Decimals, percentages and their equivalent fractions; algebra; coordinates; translation and reflection; as well as nets of 3D shapes.

Spring 2

Perimeter, area and volume; ratio; and calculating the size of angles.

Computing

1st half term - Networks and use of the Internet for Communication 2nd half term - Using Kodu to develop an interactive game

<u>Module</u>

1st half term - Design Technology - Hats. Children will be learning about different types of hats; designing their own hat for a specific user; making it; then evaluating how successful they have been.

2nd half term - Science -Our topics are light and electricity. We will shine a light on our learning by building circuits, experimenting with torches and working scientifically to prove and disprove our own theories on how we see things and how we use power.

<u>PE</u>

1st half term - Games : Hockey and Football Dance: Bhangra and 70s Disco 2nd half term - Games : Basketball

RE

During RE, children will be investigating this question:

Is it better to express your religion in arts and architecture, or in charity and generosity?

What do Religions say when life gets hard? During this unit, we will be referring to what happens after we die. Please let us know if this could be a sensitive subject for your child.

<u>Music</u>

Music will be taught in the second half term, by Miss Doogan.

Music - Looping & Remixing - Children will explore digital music by creating loops and remixes using GarageBand.

<u>PSHE</u>

1st half term - Living in the wider world and safety: images in the media, strategies to keep safe online and looking at money.

2nd half term - Living in the wider world: Gambling within gaming and links to money. Keeping money safe and online scams and how money effects our feelings.

<u>Art</u>

Art - Will be taught on cross-curricular days and will be based on the work of Keith Haring and Jean-Michel Basquiat.

<u>French</u>

Je me présente - focus on family, pets and hobbies.

In addition to the set homework, pupils should still be reading regularly, practising tables (TTR5) and learning spellings from the Year 3/4 and the Year 5/6 lists (which are at the back of their purple spelling books).
