

Maths

Reasoning activities. Real life applications/multi-step problems related to all mathematical concepts covered. To be able to choose an appropriate method.

Number work: Fractions, write percentages as a fraction with denominator 100, and as a decimal, recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert from one form to the other, know equivalent fractions, add and subtract fractions, comparing multiplying and problem solving with fractions.

English

Individual, whole-class and group reading and comprehension activities, spelling, punctuation and grammar work, speaking and listening, handwriting and presentation will all remain a focus.

In the first half of the Spring term our class text will be *The Highwayman* by Alfred Noyes and we will focus on classic and narrative poetry. Children will have the opportunity to perform poems.

We will then read *The Invention of Hugo Cabret* by Brian Selznick.

Accelerated Reader sessions will take place daily.
