

Year 6 Summer Term 2026

English Accelerated Reading - fiction, non-fiction.
GAPs (grammar, punctuation and spelling) and oracy.
Responses to reading. As well as non fiction and narrative writing based on our class novels.
Summer 1: *Skellig* by David Almond.
Summer 2: *When the Sky Falls* by Phil Earle.

Maths Statistics including graphs, charts and tables. Measuring and calculating angles in angles in straight and intersecting lines, triangles, quadrilaterals and other polygons. They will be drawing shapes with two dimensions given; they will learn how to use a protractor. There will also be consolidation of the topics taught throughout the year.

Computing 1st half term - **Computer Science**
Using microbits to record energy
2nd half term - Code breaking and using a range of software

Module 1st half term - Science: Evolution and Inheritance. We will explore Scientists such as Darwin and how we inherit certain traits from our ancestors.
2nd half term - History: WWII and local history in which we will visit the air-raid shelters in Stockport as evacuees and discover what life was like during the war.

Music 1st half term: Performance skills and production

To finish the unit, we will use music technology to compose a simple song.
