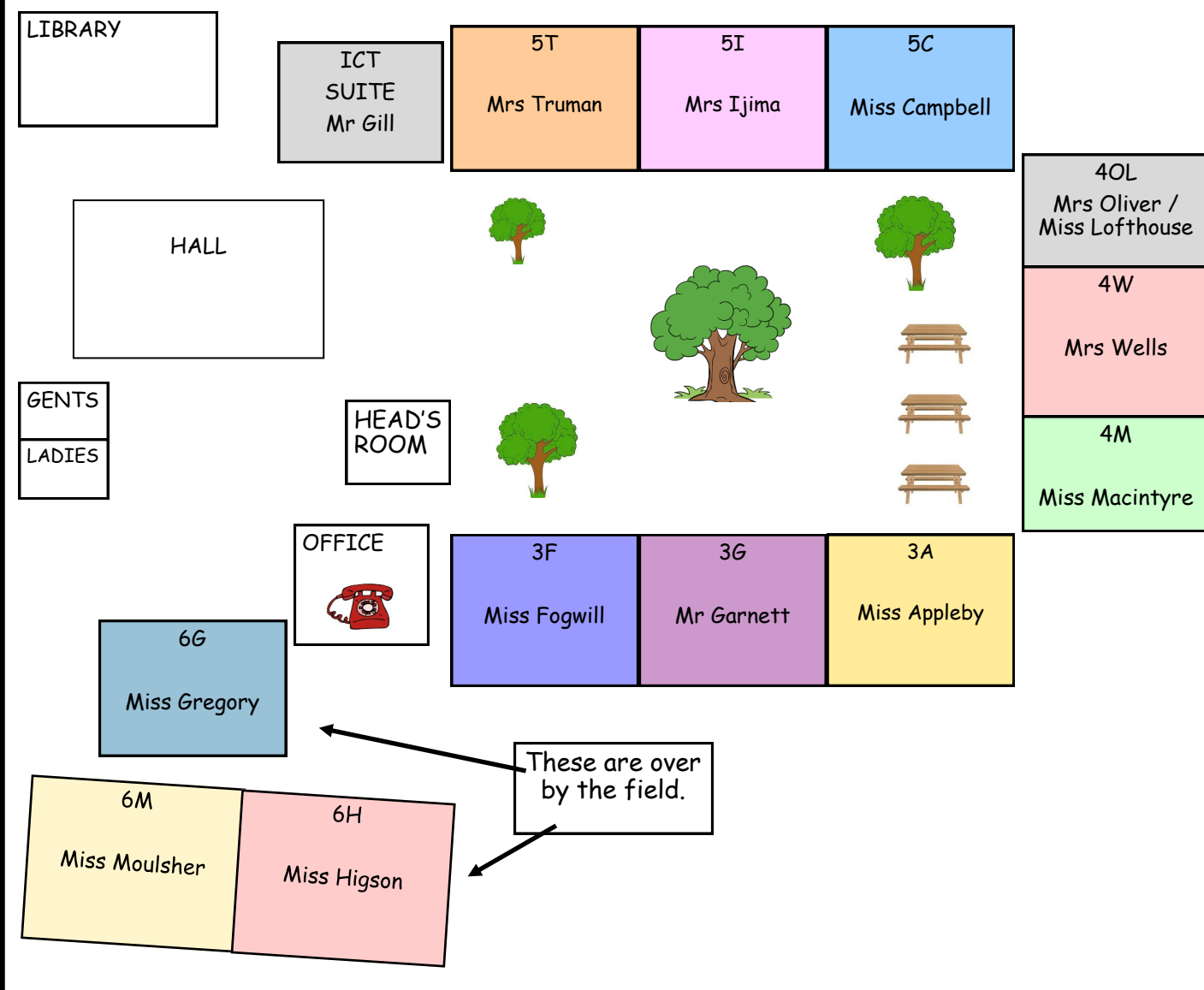
A Sad Farewell
