

Year 1 overview Summer Term 2024

English

We will be reading 'Toys in Space' and ensuring we write sentences with capital letters and full stops. We will use the conjunction 'and' when writing our own stories.



Maths

In Power Maths we will explore the basics of multiplication and division. We will develop confidence with numbers to 100. And finally we will look at measures including money and time



Science

In Science we will be learning about plants. We will be able to name the main parts of plants and trees. We will identify common plants and trees that we may find in the UK. We will plant a plant and watch it over time

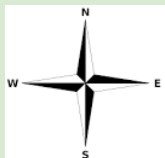
History

We will be learning about seaside holidays in the past, we will find out how holidays have changed over time. We compare holidays in Victorian times to our holidays now.



Geography

We will be exploring the weather. We will be comparing weather in hot and cold places around the world. We will learn about the compass points North, South, East and West. We will use these to make our own weather forecasts.



Art

We will be exploring sculpture, focussing on the contemporary artist Barbara Hepworth. We will practise skills relating to modelling and handling modelling clay. We will make our own simple sculptures using different techniques.



D&T

We will be designing and making a simple bridge using a range of different materials.



RE

We will be learning about the religion of Islam and learning about the basic beliefs of Muslims.



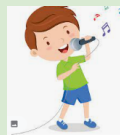
PSHE
