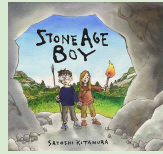


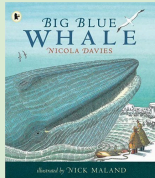
Year 3 Spring Curriculum Map

English



We will be basing our learning around the books 'Stone Age Boy' and 'Big, Blue Whale'.

Through these books we will be continuing our learning of inverted commas, past and present tense, and prefixes. We will write in different styles.



Maths



In Power Maths, we will be continuing our multiplication and division learning by looking at formal written methods. We will also cover Length and Perimeter, Fractions, Mass and Capacity. Throughout the term, we will continually recap previous learning to ensure we don't forget our skills!

Science

In Science, we will be looking at Light and Shadow. We will explore different light sources and assess their effectiveness. We will then explore how shadows are formed and change. After half term, we will move onto Forces and Magnets. We will find different push and pull forces.



History



In History, we will be continuing our learning about Prehistoric Britain. We are

now moving onto the Bronze and Iron Age. We will look at how daily life changed throughout these periods and the development of farming.

Geography

We will be exploring Rivers, Mountains and the Water Cycle. We will be looking at the key features of a river and mountain. We will use map skills to locate the different rivers and mountains. We will create our water cycle to help us understand how it works and its features.

Art

We will be looking at patterns and colours in nature to create our own fabric designs. We will look at the work of William Morris and Megan Carter to inspire us.



D & T

We will be finishing our vegetable tarts using our peeling, grating and cutting skills. We will look at pneumatic toys. We will explore different pneumatic products and have a go at making our own.



RE

This term we will continue our learning about Hinduism and the learn about the Baha'i faith.

Towards Easter, we will look at Christianity and more particularly 'The Bible'.

PSHE

We will be continuing our 'My Happy Minds' Scheme of learning. This term, we will complete the appreciation module. We will also look at Health and Wellbeing and Citizenship.

Music

In music, we will be looking at creating our own compositions based around an animation. We will explore how music can tell a story and then use a story to create our piece of music.

PE

In PE, we will be participating in gymnastics and dance.

MFL

In French, the children will be developing their knowledge of animals and how to write numbers.

Computing

We will be looking at Coding and Graphing. The children will learn how to use computer software to record information as graphs. We will then learn how to use Emails safely to communicate with others.

Additional information- We encourage the children to read at home daily and to practise their 2,3,4,5,8 and 10 times table using TTRockstars. The children's PE day is **Thursday**, the children need to come to school wearing their kits. Spelling Checks are Mondays and Homework is set on Fridays. We will have a trip to Tatton Park this term. We will also be celebrating 'World Religion Day'- Please let me know if you would like to come in and speak to the children.
