LEARNING

In Maths, the children have continued to show off their super subitising skills, quickly recognising small quantities with confidence.

We have also been learning about comparison, using mathematical language such as more than, less than and equal to compare groups of objects.

In Drawing Club, the children used their wonderful imaginations as part of our storytelling. They imagined hearing a mysterious sound coming from the woods and shared their ideas about what it could be, leading to lots of creative thinking and discussion.

PHONICS

This week in Phonics, we have been reviewing everything we have learned throughout Autumn 2. The children have now been introduced to lots of new phonemes, digraphs and tricky words, and we have been focusing on embedding this knowledge and building confidence in using it.

The children have also taken part in assessments, which will help us identify any gaps in learning and ensure we can provide the right support moving forward.
