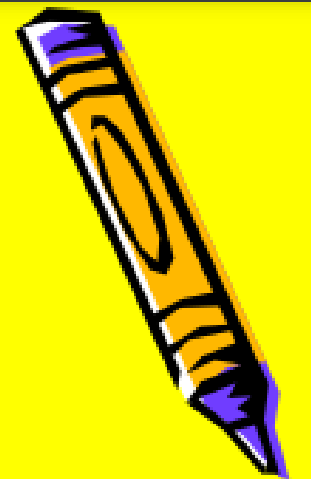

# Class Rules

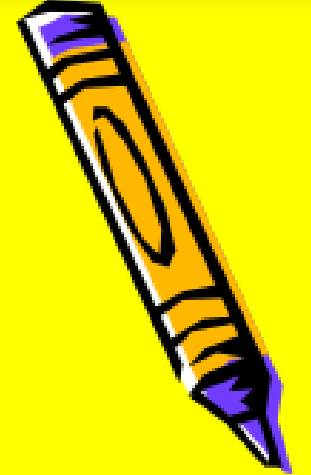
- Respect your peers and teachers

P.E KIT and shoes!

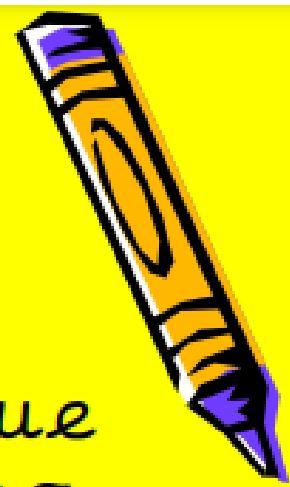
Water bottles also

Backpacks just take up too much room in our cloakrooms and there is no room for them. They will have the opportunity to use backpacks in the Juniors!

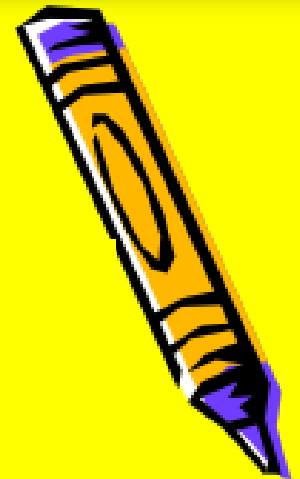


# Timetable
