Maths

- Practise the basics at home including addition, subtraction, multiplication tables and division facts
- Pupils should know all multiplication tables and be able to recall them rapidly
- Problem solving
- Quick mental recall encourage the daily use of apps such as One Minute Maths, TT Rockstars and Hit the Button
