Our class topic is... **HERE, THERE, EVERYWHERE**

Here are some of the ways in which your child will be learning during this Autumn Term 1.

Language, Literacy and Communication:

• In English, we will begin by looking at the poem Jaberwocky, exploring different types of words that are used.

We will then begin writing our own stories choosing a different genre each time.

• As a class, our class book is The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe..

• To develop our reading, we will have daily guided reading sessions to practise reading strategies and comprehension.

• To develop our spelling, we will have daily spelling activities where we will learn and practise different spelling patterns.

Cymraeg:

• In Welsh, we will begin reinforcing our incidental welsh language patterns and begin to use third person to talk about other people.

Mathematics and Numeracy:

In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of the four operations of number:

- Addition
- Subtraction
- Multiplication
- Division

We will also explore the following and link them to our '**Here, There, Everywhere**' topic:

- Place value
- Coordinates
- Solving worded problems

RVE:

In Religion, Values and Ethics, our first half term focus will be '**Creation and Covenant**'. We will be covering topics such as:

- The Call of Abraham
- God's Covenant with Abraham
- Abraham and Sarah
- Abraham and Isaac
- Joseph, the Teenager
- Joseph and His Family



<p><u>HEALTH AND WELLBEING</u></p> <p>Health and wellbeing is an important part of the curriculum. Alongside PE and Forest School, the children's wellbeing will always be at the forefront of my mind while they are in the class.</p> <p>The curriculum sessions which come under this heading are PE and Forest School. (Details of our next Forest School rotation will be sent out to you later in the term).</p> <p>Alongside these, they will also take part in PSHE sessions which will focus on developing well-being.</p>	<p><u>EXPRESSIVE ARTS</u></p> <p>Within Expressive Arts, the children will create their own designs and work collaboratively with others to develop creative ideas linked to our topic.</p> <p>They will have opportunities to explore how creative work can represent, document, share and celebrate personal, social and cultural identities.</p>	<p><u>SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY</u></p> <p>For most of the term our focus will be materials. We will begin by exploring natural materials and the children will consider their uses during our topic. Which included how and why we import and export our materials.</p>
<p><u>HUMANITIES</u></p> <p>Within our Humanities work, we will focus on activities that relate to our topic 'Here, There, everywhere'. Beginning with Wales and the UK.</p> <p>We will be starting our learning with a 'pupil voice' session so the children are involved in the topics they are learning about.</p>	<p><u>Digital Competency:</u></p> <p>Lots of our sessions will require use of Hwb or other digital platforms for a range of purposes. The children will also be asked to put some of their independent learning tasks on Seesaw so their work can be shared with family.</p>	<p><u>Behaviour</u></p> <p>Within class I will manage all behaviour positively to help to support individuals. As a class we have come up with our class rules and all children have agreed to follow these.</p>
