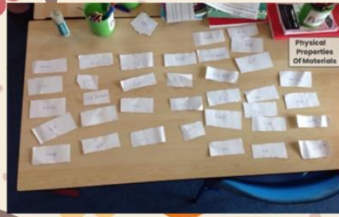


In RE we have discussed The Rosary. We made our own Rosary beads.

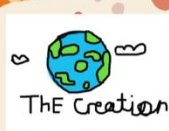
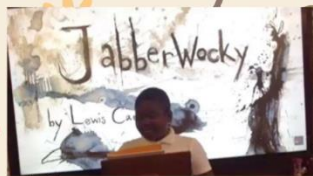


WOW I cannot believe we are at the end of our first half term already!

St Anthony's School Uniform Reminder

**Hair:**

For health and safety reasons, we ask that all long hair is tied back neatly, with no loose strands left hanging. This helps to avoid accidents during play, PE and practical activities, and it also keeps children comfortable and focused in class.

**Earrings:**

If your child wears earrings, these must be studs only. Hoop earrings or dangly styles are not safe for school as they can easily get caught during play or PE. Thank you for supporting us in keeping everyone safe.

**Footwear:**

Please make sure your child comes to school in sensible, sturdy shoes that are suitable for the weather and running and playing outside. Fashion shoes aren't always practical for school life and can cause slips or trips.

**Coats:**

Now that autumn has arrived, the weather is turning cooler and less predictable. We kindly ask that children bring a suitable coat to school every day so they can enjoy outdoor play and learning, whatever the weather!
