St Anthony's School Uniform Reminder

Hair: For health and safety reasons, we ask that all long hair is tied back neatly, with no loose strands left hanging. This helps to avoid accidents during play, PE and practical activities, and it also keeps children comfortable and focused in class. Earrings: If your child wears earrings, these must be studs only. Hoop earrings or dangly styles are not safe for school as they can easily get caught during play or PE. Thank you for supporting us in keeping everyone safe.
