Each cost 10p. How many cakes does he have altogether? Betty has 30 chicken nuggets, she shares them between 6 people. How many nuggets do they have each? Touch and turn the object, describing each aspect in detail to your partner and then swap places. Ask someone to drop a feather and watch it very closely as it floats to the ground. Listen carefully to a piece of music and draw a line on a piece of paper which matches the feeling created by the music.</p>
