### **READING**

To help your child progress in English, daily reading continues to be a high priority; thank you for your support completing the Summer Reading Project and we hope that you found this useful and enjoyable.

Home Reading should cover a range of different types of texts. A major emphasis of the reading in Year 5 is ensuring good understanding of what has been read. Discussing the text, the characters and language used in a book is of great value, as is discussing personal response and feelings about the text. In the next few weeks, your child will be bringing home their latest Book Drop text which we hope you will enjoy together. Reading book pages read and a list of any new vocabulary that you have discussed, should be recorded in the homework diary and initialled each night by a parent.
