READING

To help your child progress in English, daily reading continues to be a high priority. Children will be given their own reading book to read each evening. They should bring their reading book in school every day. Books will be changed on a Tuesday and Thursday. Please aim to read a few pages each evening and discuss what has been read. Remember to keep the reading experience positive. Each child will have the opportunity to visit the school library to take a book home. Homeschool diaries should be initialled each night by a parent and signed weekly.

SEESAW APP

In Year 1, we use the Seesaw app to support your child's learning in school. Teachers and children will upload examples of work completed in class, giving you a window into what your child is learning. Some homework tasks will also be set on Seesaw. These will be clearly outlined in the homework overview available on the class page. There is no need to upload or send in photos of any work your child completes at home unless we specifically ask for it.
