READING

To help your child progress in English, daily reading continues to be a high priority.

Home Reading should cover a range of different types of texts. A major emphasis of the reading in Year 2 is ensuring good understanding of what has been read. Discussing the text, the characters and language used in a book is of great value, as is discussing personal response and feelings about the text. In the next few weeks, your child will be reading daily and a list of any new vocabulary that you have discussed, should be recorded in the homework diary and initialled each night by a parent.

Reading books and diaries need to be brought into school each day. New reading books will be given out on a Tuesday and a Thursday.
