The Little Red Hen

This week our special story has been **The Little Red Hen**. The children have learnt how to retell this story using actions and a special drawing called a **story map**. You could ask your child if they can tell you the story at home!

In the story, the Little Red Hen collects some **wheat** and takes it to the **mill** to be ground into **flour**. She then uses the flour to bake some **bread**. This inspired us to make our very own bread rolls! The children did a super job of mixing the **ingredients** and kneading the **dough**. There has been a delicious smell of bread in the EYFS Unit all week! We hope the children all enjoyed eating their bread at home!
