







Number fun!

We have been working super hard to learn our numbers to 20 over the last couple of weeks. To help us develop a really deep understanding of these numbers, we explore them using a wide range of resources and visual representations. You can see just a few of these on this page.

You could help your child to really embed their learning at home by:

- Counting forwards to 20. Try starting at different numbers, rather than always starting at 1.
- Counting backwards from 20 to 0.
- Practise reading numbers when you are out and about.
- Practice touch counting quantities of objects found around the home. This could include things like toy cars, bath toys, dried pasta.
- Hide numbers around the house and play a hide and seek game.
- Watch the teens number episodes of Numberblocks on BBC iPlayer.
