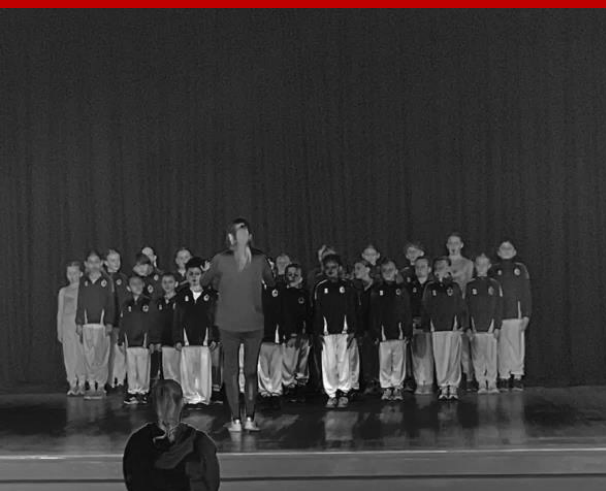

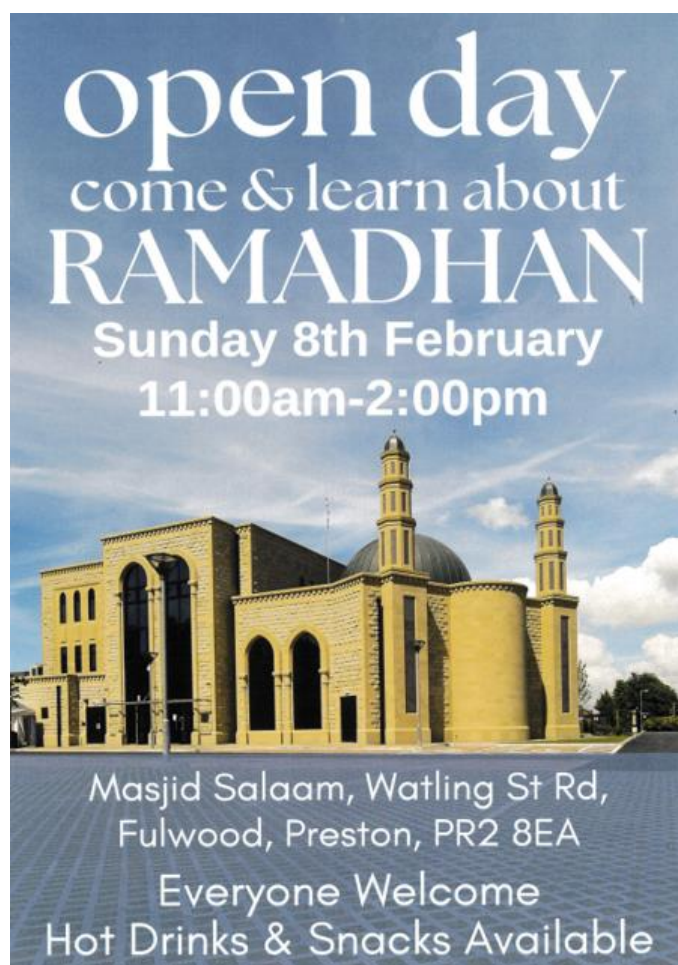
WELFARE VACANCY
