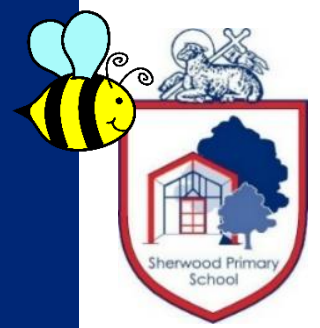

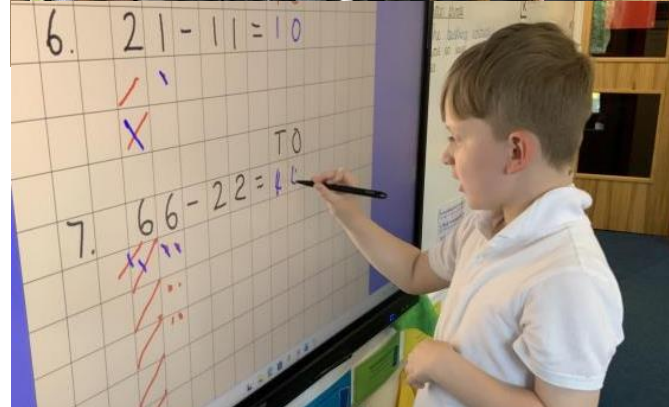
SPELLING BEE

We are delighted to share that we are launching Junior Parkrun at Sherwood this half term.

On Sunday 28th June, we will attend our first Junior Parkrun with our children and families. We will introduce the initiative in assemblies (with the help of Toby Y5 – our Parkrun ambassador) and then join together for our **first Sherwood Junior Parkrun** on Sunday 28th June (9am start).
