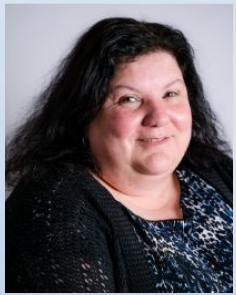

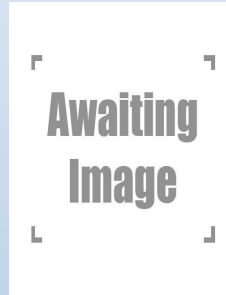

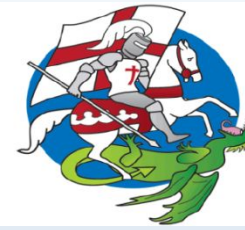
Y6 science lessons will occur in the lab. This will help us to create opportunities to enhance and enrich our high-quality science learning.

As in Year 5, we will continue to use Google Classroom in innovative ways for children to engage in blended learning away from the classroom to review and consolidate learning..

Daily Home Reading – should be recorded in reading logs (expected 4 times a week, but there is no limit).

Zumos

We will continue to use Zumos in school and would encourage you to use it at home with your child.

We have put the Zumos Parent Presentation on the year group page of the website for you.

Through Zumos, the children are able to access:

- Meditation and visualisations
- Breathing techniques for relaxation
- Games - playing the games for 10 mins 3 times per week can alter their cognitive bias. Changing negative feelings into more positive responses.
- Life Book
- Power Quizzes (3 x per year)
- Worry Box - they can communicate with their teacher to tell them about their worries.



Learning Mentor

Mrs Rice's role includes working with children, parents, carers, teachers and other agencies on various issues which may affect a child's learning. These can include:

- Punctuality and Attendance
- Changes in behaviour causing detriment to learning
- Friendship issues
- Low self-esteem and confidence
- Settling in of new children
- Transition to their new class, key stage or high school
- Support parents or carers with routines, managing behaviour at home
- A point of contact for parents and carers on a daily basis.

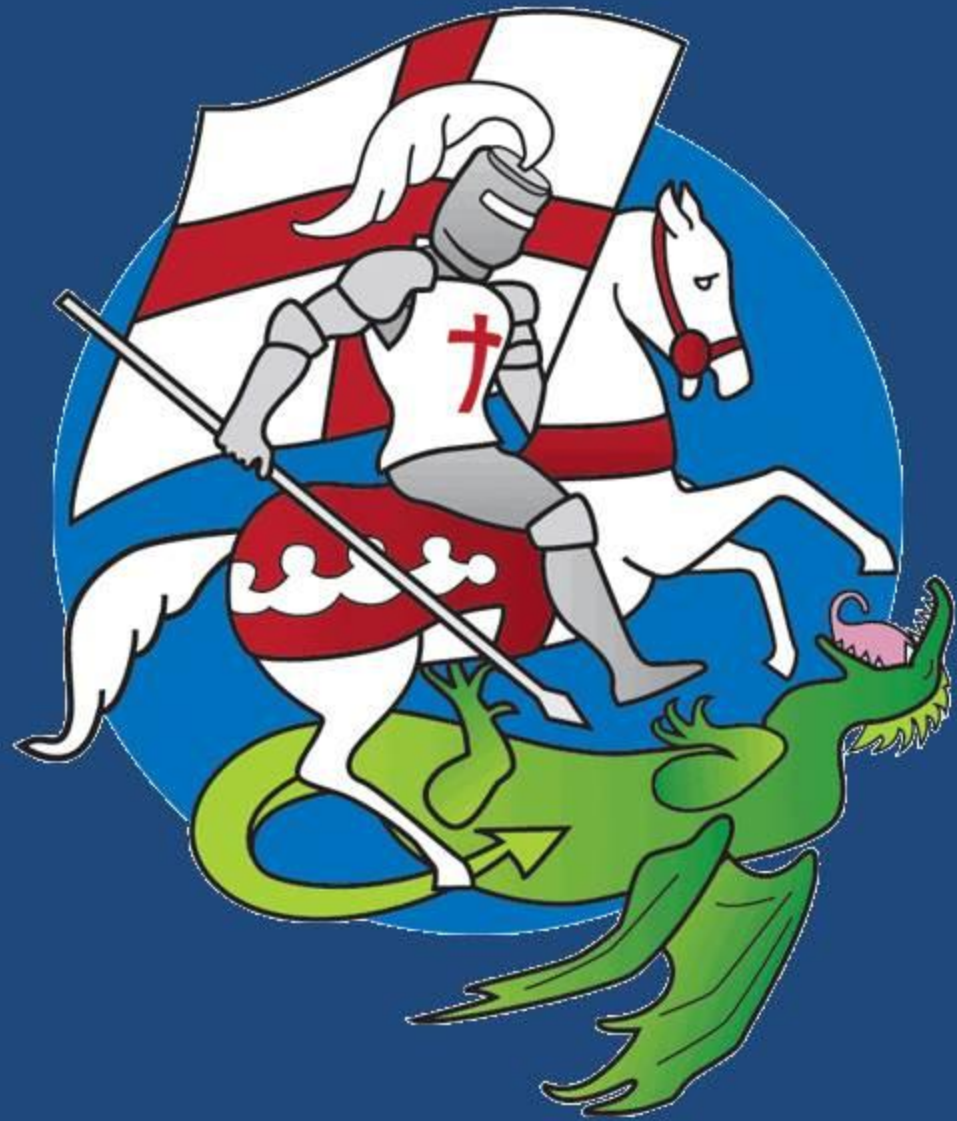
