<p>Literacy and speaking and listening</p>	<p>Write a list of words you can think of that end with these suffixes <i>-ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly</i></p> <p>For example, <i>payment, beautiful, careless or sparkly.</i></p>	<p>Can you think of any other stories you know with nocturnal animals in? What are they called? Which is your favourite?</p>	<p>Go to the library and choose a story to read at home. Write a short book review about your book. <p>Maths and problem solving</p>	<p>Practise finding the doubles and halves of all numbers to 20. When you know these, keep practising $\div 2$, $\div 10$ and $\div 5$ facts.</p> 	<p>Measure how long, heavy, tall or how much water something can hold at home. What will you need to measure the different things? Which measurements will you use?</p>	<p>Share some fruit, cake or pizza with someone. Practise cutting your food into halves, quarters or thirds, making sure each part is the same size.</p> 	<p>Have a look at different coins and bank notes. Can you count the amount? Set up a shop at home and practise adding together totals and finding change.</p> 
<p>Science and topic</p>	<p>When you are outside, have a look to see if you can spot any plants or wildlife. What type of habitat do they live in? Research different types of habitats.</p>	<p>Think about an owl. Could you find out what kind of habitat they need to survive in?</p> 	<p>Research owls or another nocturnal animal on the internet. What can you find out? Write some facts about the nocturnal animal you chose.</p>	<p>Create a poster titled: 'Why we should save the environment' Try to persuade other to save the environment.</p>
