Literacy Speaking and Listening	Write your own story. Who will be in your story? What will happen? Where will you go?	Look at the story Little Red Riding Hood. Can you write about what happens? 	Go to the library and choose a book to read about animals. What did you find out?	Can you make a list of all the different materials you know and their properties? For example, wood is hard and strong.
Maths and problem solving 	Practise counting forwards and backwards twos. Can you write your two times tables in order?	Can you write all the numbers from 0-20 in words?	Help your grown up in the kitchen and use some weighing scales to measure out the ingredients you will need. 	How many number bonds to 20 can you find?
Science and Topic 	Can you paint a picture from the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears? 	Talk to the grown up in your family about their favourite toys from when they were little. Are they different to the toys you have?	Write an algorithm for going to bed. What do you do before you go to bed? What order to you do them in? If you follow your algorithm, does it work?	Can you build a house using different materials? Which house was the strongest? Which was the weakest?
