
You **all** know the rules when using the toilets.

In Year 5 it is your responsibility to report any issues to an adult straight away.




GIRLS

DINNER TIME


Year 5 normally go out to play first at dinnertime. We play on the big yard, near the MUGA. We get called to the hall around 12.30pm.

If it is wet play, we will remain in our classrooms until called to the hall for our dinner.




In the afternoons, we cover lots of different subjects and topics. Can you guess what they might be?


