




Next, we begin our Maths lesson. In Maths, we normally start our learning using a Flash Back Four and a "You will need" list...


DINNER TIME


Year 5 normally go out to play first at dinnertime. We play on the big yard, near the MUGA. We get called to the hall around 12.30pm.

In the afternoons, we cover lots of different subjects and topics. Can you guess what they might be?













