





Classes.






Once you come in, you walk up the nearest staircase and head straight to your cloakroom.




We are now going to have a walk through of our daily routines...

The Incredible Book Eating Boy




Henry loves books... but not like you and I. He loves to EAT books! This exciting story follows the trials and tribulations of a boy with a voracious appetite for books.


But a book-eating diet isn't the healthiest of habits, as Henry soon finds out...


The Secret of Black Rock

- Use quiet voices








In the afternoons, we cover lots of different subjects and topics. Can you guess what they might be?














Did you get any right? In Year 3, different teachers teach different subjects.
