Let's go and see these spaces outside... Where do you think we would go for a Fire Drill?






You will then enter the door at your classroom.

- Be timely go in, use the toilet, wash up, leave


RESPECTFUL

Metacognition is like being a brain superhero! It means knowing how and when to use our superpowers in order to think and learn.




