



Let's look at a 'typical' day in Year 6.

We can use the 4 square and sometimes get a chance to go on the MUGA. We use the same toilets that you used in Year 5.


Please remember to be respectful in the toilets and the same to be respectful in the toilets.



In Reading, we learn how to read through texts carefully, discuss vocabulary and answer questions using different skills.








10:50 - 12:00

DINNER TIME


Year 6 will go outside and get called in for lunch first. We get to go on the MUGA at lunch around 12:30.

Today, sit on the same tables as last year! We may change these at some point soon.


We must remember to follow the dinnertime rules.

In the afternoons, we cover lots of different subjects and topics. Can you guess what they might be?
















Home time is at 3.05pm




