Please find information listed about the curriculum which will be taught throughout this half term.

Subject	Topic this half term	Additional notes
English	Reading This half term we will be enjoying daily story times using books the children have chosen at our 'voting station.' Small guided reading groups will take place throughout the week which will support home reading and focus on developing our inference, prediction and sequencing skills as well as decoding the text. Writing Our English topics this half term are a recount of 'Our Trip to the Woods' and a poetry unit 'When I am by myself' We will be building on the skills taught in reception as well as writing longer sentence applying our new phonic knowledge Phonics We will be starting our phonics scheme and getting to grips with a new way of working! Children are streamed into groups for phonics and each group work independently.	Reading Reading is so important throughout school and we ask you to read you're your child each night, even if it is just 5 minutes. Please make a note in their reading record so that we know when books are ready to be changed. <i>Please can you ensure reading books are in school bags every day as children may be called to read on any day.</i> Reading and library books are changed on a Friday. Spellings We will soon be giving out spellings. These will be tested on a Friday. Please practice these throughout the week. Score will be added to homework books which should be returned to school on a Thursday.
Maths	This half term we will be recapping our prior learning and building upon it. Our focus is place value (understanding what numbers represent and their order) and addition and subtraction within 10.	Maths at home All children will soon be given a log in for the Numbots website. This is a great resource to support our maths learning. The games are also great fun and there are certificates for those who work hard!
R.E	Our focus this half term is ' Who do Christians say made the world? ' We will look the creation story and Harvest festival.	
Computing	In computing we will be introducing the basic skills needed to use computer programmes.	
Science	Our Science topic is Identifying and naming materials in which there will be lots of practical learning using natural and man-made materials	Please could you ensure that the children always keep a pair of wellies in school as we often go outside whatever the weather to discover the great



		outdoors.
PSHE	This half term our focus is - Me and my relationships . We will be discussing our emotions and the feelings of others.	
History	This half term our focus is History , and we will be looking at L.S Lowry and the Industrial Revolution . We will be learning about the artist's work and how it helps us to understand life at that time.	If you have any Lowry prints at home we would love to share them in class.
Art	Our topic this half term will focus on developing the skills of Drawing – Making your mark . We will look at different types of line work and how to use pencils effectively to create.	
P.E.	In PE, we will be working on fundamentals skills and Dance . In fundamentals we will be learning about moving in different ways such as running and skipping, and changing direction. In dance we will learn about how to count in beats of 8 and use our creative skills to make u dances.	PE days are Thursdays and Fridays . Please send your child in their PE uniform on those days. Pumps should be left in school for indoor activities.
Music	We are very ucky to be supported by the Alpha Music Team who will be helping us to teach the skills of music performance, creation and appraisal.
