BREAKFAST AND AFTERSCHOOL CLUB

Our Breakfast and After-School Clubs are now moving to a weekly booking system.

Bookings for the upcoming weeks will open for parents on the 16th of each month via your **School Spider** account.

Please note:

- . Once a booking is made, we are unable to cancel it.
- . A £30 deposit is required to use the club, which will be refunded when your child no longer requires the service.

To help with costs, you may be eligible for tax-free childcare. For more information on how to apply for this and the process for using childcare vouchers, please see the details provided below.

Our after-school club offers a variety of activities and includes a snack for all children.

- . Breakfast Club (8:00 a.m. 8:45 a.m.): £3.00
- . After-school Club (3:15 p.m. 5:15 p.m.): £4.50
- . Late Stay Club (3:15 p.m. 6:00 p.m.): £7.50

We also offer a discounted rate for siblings using the facility.

Please ensure if you have any invoice on school spider that you pay them as soon as possible as to not risk not being able to use the club going forward.

Verifying Your Vouchers

To apply your Tax-Free Childcare payments to your account, you'll need to send us a couple of things after you've made a payment from your government account:

Your child's unique code (this is on your childcare account and ends in TFC). Please email this to the office as soon as you have it for our records.

A screenshot of your payment from the government website. This screenshot should be uploaded to the voucher section as a voucher on School Spider when you're paying for your club.

We can only verify a voucher after the funds have been transferred from the government website. We recommend making your payment from the government website first to ensure we can see it and apply it to your account without any delays.
